Since January, there has been a resurgence of civic participation; citizens worried about everything from health care to the integrity of our democracy. While the worries are vast, a common thread persists: the struggle to get ahead has never seemed harder, as many people are working harder for less despite overall economic growth.

As an owner at Colorado's employee-owned New Belgium Brewery described it, "The sweet spot for employee-owned companies is going to work every day at a place where we have a stake in the outcome and a say in how we get there."

Companies can choose to begin as an employee-owned model or can convert into one. There are a variety of options: Employee Stock Ownership Plans (ESOPs), Worker Cooperatives, stock options, and formalized profit-sharing -- for example.

While Colorado is home to numerous employee-owned companies, we must do more to encourage this type of model and their growth. The WORK Act will help accelerate the proliferation of profit-sharing businesses and bring to scale similar legislation that the Colorado legislature passed this year. Under the WORK Act, Colorado will be situated to vie for funds for existing employee-ownership programs that will help businesses explore and make the transition.

The bottom line is we should recognize that income inequality threatens our democracy and civil society. Our democracy can only thrive when the middle class thrives, as the engine of our country. Employee-owned businesses are one way we can ensure more people have a fair shot at the American Dream and increase overall productivity.


